## Position Description

Lifeguard

Corning Aquatic Center

## General Summary:

Supervision of patrons and enforcement of Aquatic Center rules

## Essential Functions:

1. Monitor all Aquatic Center patrons, in and out of the water
2. Enforce all safety rules and regulations of the Aquatic Center
3. Document and record all major patron disciplinary problems
4. Provide primary first aid to Aquatic Center patrons
5. Prepare all necessary documents and reports relating to accidents
6. Perform daily maintenance of facilities
7. Teach assigned swim classes (if certified)
8. Public relations
9. Concessions and Admission when scheduled
10. Other duties as assigned by the Head Lifeguard or Aquatic Center Manager

## Knowledge, Skills & Abilities

1. Able to lift 50 pounds
2. Able to use various tools for maintenance of facilities
3. Able to climb ladders
4. Able to stand or sit for extended periods of time
5. Able to communicate knowledge of operations, skills, and training to personnel and students of various ages

## Entry Level Requirements

1. Current American Red Cross Lifeguard Training Certificate
2. Water Safety Instructor Certificate, not required but preferred
3. Red Cross CPR for the Professional Rescuer
4. Red Cross Standard First Aid

## Working Conditions:

1. Report to Head Life Guard and Aquatic Center Manager
2. Normal work hours will require morning, afternoon, evening, and weekend shifts
3. Position is seasonal
4. Performance of duties will require frequent and extensive outdoor exposure both in and out of pool water
5. Vigorous physical activity
6. Possible exposure to hazardous chemicals
